## Assessment to identify legal or customary use rights, existing within the estates, of plantation workers and villagers who live adjacent to our estates

#### 1. Introduction

A questionnaire survey was conducted to identify the legal or customary use rights, existing within the estates, of plantation workers and villagers who live adjacent to our estates.

The assessment was carried out in four plantation Groups and adjacent villages. Collectively about 3000 residence and non residence employees are working in four groups. All the plantation groups are surrounded by villages.

#### 2. Objective of the survey

- 1. Finding out the customary use rights of the plantation workers and the villagers who live adjacent to the estates
- 2. Finding out the use rights of the plantation workers and neighboring community that are negatively affected by the estates Management of the company.

#### **3.** Methodology of the survey

The survey was based on a questionnaire printed in Sinhalese language.

The survey was conducted Group wise. Both workers and villagers from each Group were interviewed randomly. The questionnaire was explained to the interviewee by interviewer since majority of estate workers had a low literacy level.


Results were analyzed statistically.

a. Sex




The results indicate that people from different age groups have been incorporated in the survey.


Results indicate that people of all plantation Groups collect firewood from plantations/ forests belonging to estates. Except Pitiakande Group a higher proportion the interviewed' people of all other three Groups collects firewood form the estates.

#### d. Question No 2,

Do you use water from wells of the estate or streams drawn through the estates?




Results for the choice 'Yes' is significantly higher than the result for choice 'No'. Therefore, we can conclude that comparatively very higher proportion of interviewed people use water sources in the Estates for their requirements.


Almost 100% of the interviewed people use the roads network of the Estates for their day today purposes.


According to the results it is very clear that people can visit culturally important places since 100% of the interviewed people have given the answer 'yes'.




Here, 76% of the people have given the answer 'Yes'. According to the results, a larger proportion of the interviewed people use the burial grounds located in the Estates premises. Most of the villages have burial Grounds in their villagers and they usually do not use Estates' burial grounds.


Both 'Yes' and 'No' answers have been given by the interviewed people. People who has said 'Yes' indicates that there are other services than the services mentioned in first six questions. The following services have been mentioned by the interviewed people as the extra services provided by the estates.

- 1. Providing monetary donations to the culturally important places (e. g. Temples and Kovils)
- 2. Providing donations for schools
- 3. Provision of the estate vehicles to villagers for their urgencies
- 4. Providing sanitation facilities to the workers
- 5. Providing nutritious food for feeding mothers and their children
- 6. Providing medical facilities
- 7. Helping villagers in social activities by providing monetary and material donations such as water, paints and coconut.

#### i. Question No 7,

Are there any negative influences from the estate management for your routine activities which are undertaken according to the rules and regulations of the country?

By looking at the results it can be clearly concluded that there is no negative influence of the estate management on the routine activities of the estate workers and villagers.

#### 5. Conclusion

Both workers and villagers of different age groups have been interviewed to identify the legal or customary use rights existing within the plantations. According to the survey a conclusion can be given that those workers and villagers of the estates have following such rights.

- 1. People can collect firewood from the plantations/ forests belonging to the estates that are required for their routine life.
- 2. People can use wells and streams for their water requirements
- 3. People can use the roads of the estate for their private transport purposes
- 4. People are allowed to visit culturally important places located in the estates.
- 5. People can use the burial grounds located in the estates

Results of the question number 7 strongly denote that there is no negative influence from the estate management on the routine life of the workers and villagers.

In addition estate workers d villagers are provided with following facilities for their day today life.

- 1. Providing monetary donations to the culturally important places (e. g. Temples and Kovils)
- 2. Providing donations for schools
- 3. Provision of the estate vehicles to villagers for their urgencies
- 4. Providing sanitation facilities to the workers
- 5. Providing nutritious food for feeding mothers and their children
- 6. Providing medical facilities
- 7. Helping villagers in social activities by providing monetary and material donations such as water, paints and coconut
